We have now received the Automated External Defibrillator (or AED). It will be fitted in a cabinet on the outside wall of the Village hall.

A plaque will be placed next it to acknowledge that Somerleyton Award Charities funded the whole cost of the defibrillator and its cabinet.

A training session has been organised for the 12th of September at 19.00 in the Village Hall. Posters have been distributed widely and we hope many people from the villages will come. We have also invited staff from the School, Estate and the Pub.

The training session will be conducted by the Community Heart Trust (CHT). It is not a formal classroom course, but designed to answer questions, give basic instruction, be interactive and create confidence in using the equipment.
