Neighbourhood plan: For Ashby, Somerleyton, Herringfleet and Lound. A summary of the final draft of the neighbourhood plan has now been distributed as a pamphlet to every household and business in these parishes as part of the consultation phase. Formal consultees including Suffolk County Council, Natural England and others will also be invited to respond. The plan defines local policies to guide development through to 2036 and once approved will become a statutory consideration in all planning decisions. The consultation is being held until February 26 and it is hoped that drop-in meetings will be held in Somerleyton and Lound in February, Covid-19 restrictions permitting.
